First Time Participants:

Archery ~ Beginning Rifle ~ Living History

Experienced Participants:

Archery: taking it for their first or second time.

Advanced Archery: taking it for their third or more time.

Pistol: must have already taken the rifle discipline.

Intermediate Rifle: taking it for their second or more time.

Advanced Rifle: limited to 6 participants who have taken three prior sessions of rifle; is for serious shooters using competitive gear in three shooting positions; not for shooters on FHRC/4-H Team.

Shotgun: must have already taken the rifle discipline; taking it for their first or second time.

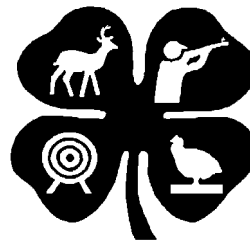
Advanced Shotgun: taking it for third or more time.

Muzzleloading: must have already taken the rifle discipline.

Hunting: must have already taken the rifle discipline.

Action Shooting: limited to 10 participants who have taken the pistol discipline twice and shotgun discipline once.
