These projects DO NOT go through the sale ring at the fair(s).

**Project Book:** Appropriate Record/Resource Books: Ohio 4-H Family Guide

FFA: On-line or Hard Copy Book

**Enrollment Deadline:** All 4-H Membership forms include project entry info. These are due

April 15<sup>th</sup> to the OSU Extension Office. FFA Exhibitors must sign-up for their projects through the FFA Advisor and due to the OSU Extension Office April 15<sup>th</sup>. FFA advisors will provide lists to the Jr. Fairboard regarding members enrolled in specific projects. This is different from

Market Livestock entries.

**Animal Requirements:** Breeding project animal cannot be used as any other 4-H/FFA

project animal. Exhibitors must own animals used in showmanship. (i.e.-A beef feeder calf cannot be shown in 4-H/FFA as a beef heifer

project)

What Fair will I show at? Washington County Fair (only Jr. Fair show for all breeding/fancy projects)

Barlow Fair (Jr. Fair Showmanship for Beef, Dairy, Goat, Sheep) Barlow Fair (Jr. Fair Rabbit/Poultry Show and Showmanship)

Youth can participate in any of the three fairs in the county for open class

Ohio State Fair – Deadline for reservations is June 20
