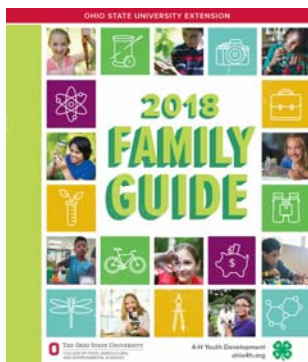

Fair Checks

DID YOU KNOW??



Are you curious about where your livestock sales checks come from? When you should expect them and the process?? Read further for all your questions to be answered...

Waterford Fair

Livestock Checks from the Waterford Fair which includes the hog species are processed through the Waterford Fair board treasurer. The fair will process the livestock checks once buyers have paid invoices. The checks are mailed from the Waterford Fair board office. If you have not received it, you should contact a Waterford Fair board member.

Washington County Fair

Livestock checks from the Washington County Fair are handled through the Washington County Market Livestock Committee. The committee waits until all buyers have paid invoices from the sale. Once the buyers have paid the committee volunteers work to get the checks processed and to exhibitors. The checks typically arrive in late October. If you have not received a check from the livestock committee by December please contact a livestock committee member.



Barlow Fair

Livestock checks from the Barlow Fair which include the Feeder calves, Market dairy goats, and market ducks are processed through the Barlow Independent Fair. The fair will process the livestock checks once buyers have paid invoices and checks are mailed from the Barlow Fair office once all buyers have paid invoices. If you have not received your check in a reasonable time, you should contact a Barlow fair board member.

Scholarship amounts and requirements vary, but application focus is on 4-H participation and leadership. Application ONLY available online and MUST complete online application by Feb. 15. Visit www.ohio4h.org click on Families and then click on Just for Teens, click on Awards & Scholarships.

Ohio 4-H Achievement Awards

These 25 awards recognize a 4-H member's achievement in a specific area. Areas include: Beef, CARTEENS, Citizenship & Community Service, Clothing & Textiles, Companion Animals, Dairy, Dairy Goat, Environmental Sciences, Family Life & Child Development, Foods & Nutrition, Gardening & Horticulture, Health & Safety, Horse, Leadership, Meat Goat, Mechanical & Engineering Sciences, Personal Development, Photography, Poultry, Rabbits, Sheep, Shooting Sports, Swine, Woodworking and Veterinary Science. Award recipients receive paid trip to National 4-H Congress in Atlanta, Georgia. Complete the Ohio 4-H Achievement Record (must follow guidelines listed on application regarding font & formatting). Applicants must be at least 14 years old and currently enrolled in Ohio 4-H. In 2017 Washington County had 3 first alternate winners: Maggie Gottfried—Photography, Caroline Stollar—Personal Development, Austin Offenberger—Carteens

Fall Leaf Fun

No matter where you live in Ohio, you're not far from finding trees covered in a huge array of reds, oranges, yellows, greens, purples, browns, and lots of other colors in between. Fall's explosion of colors and Ohio's abundance of trees make this a great opportunity to talk with Cloverbuds about how, like fall's leaves, we all have similarities and differences, and to do a couple of activities that help Cloverbuds make connections that, like tree leaves in the fall, we show our true colors when we recognize, respect, and celebrate each other's uniqueness.

At a park or other location with several different kinds of trees and their fall leaves:

Ask

- *What do you notice about all the leaves on these trees?* – encourage responses and help Cloverbuds focus on leaf colors, shapes, sizes, still attached, fallen off, etc.
- *How many different colors do you see?* – offer additional color descriptors that might be new to Cloverbuds, such as rust, ruby, mauve, crimson, amber, gold, bronze, olive, ochre, etc.
- *How would describe the shapes of the leaves? How about their sizes?* – talk with the Cloverbuds about their observations.
- *How many different leaves can you find?* – give each Cloverbud a grocery bag and ask them to collect different kinds, shapes, and colors of leaves.

Do

- Explain to the Cloverbuds they are going to use the leaves they collected to make a leaf person... a picture that represents them!
- Give each Cloverbud a piece of construction paper and a glue stick (optional: craft wiggle-eyes or corn or soybean kernels). If they have trouble creating their leaf person, ask questions to get them to consider how they could arrange the leaves to look like a stick figure—*what shape leaf would make a good head? Arms? Legs Feet? Hands? Mouth? Ears? Nose? Hair?* If needed, make an example to show them.

Reflect

When they've completed their leaf person, bring their attention back and ask:

- *What do you notice about our leaf people?* – help the group focus on the uniqueness and differences each leaf person has, similar to how each Cloverbud is different and unique in their own special way.
- *What it would be like if each one of us was exactly the same?* – talk with the Cloverbuds about their observations, maintaining respect for everyone in the group and summarize with a statement that reflects your appreciation for the diversity each Cloverbud brings to the group.
