ALL project books must be in print form.

Enrollment Form Due: April 15 – completed enrollments turned in between April 16 and May 1 will be accepted with a \$10 late fee. After May 1 **NO LATE ENROLLMENTS WILL BE ACCEPTED**

Project Animal Requirements: See Back

Pre-Fair Tag-In: 1st Saturday in June, 8-10 am (can tag-in maximum of 3), Washington Co. Fairgrounds

*Castrated, hornless and healed by date of tag in

*Fair weight limits: Min. 350# Max. 700#

*Blue Breed Verification Card due on or before June tag-in or not eligible for project

Quality Assurance: Exhibitor and one parent/guardian **must** attend one of the sessions offered in Washington County or any other Ohio County.

Skillathon: Skillathon is **required** for exhibitor to be eligible to show and/or sell at the fair

What happens at the Fair?

Check in – 8-8:30pm - Friday (completed DUNF must be presented to committee before weighing in)

Buyer Thank you posters – make a Thank You poster to thank previous buyer. Hang it in the barn. See Jr Fair Guide for details and size

Classes – To be eligible to sell, exhibitor **must do both** Showmanship and Market Classes

What is the Premier Exhibitor Award?

High scoring exhibitor from skillathon (100 points), showmanship (100 points) & market class placing (50 points)

Sale: Tuesday, Multi-Purpose Arena (Buyers Reception before sale).

What happens after the Sale?

Thank/contact buyers – thank buyers by note, call or in person
