<u>Project Book:</u> #139 Market Hog 1st year members, or Washington County Livestock Record Book for 2nd year members and beyond (required for Skillathon). FFA exhibitors see your advisor for requirements.

ALL project books must be in print form.

Project Animal Requirements: Hogs should weigh 55-60# in May, Barrows only, NO Gilts

*Possession: By Tag-in

*Fair weight limits: Min. 220# Max. 280#

<u>Pre-Fair Tag-In:</u> *Tag-in to be done by club advisors in May

* Can tag-in maximum of 2 hogs but show and sell 1

*Castrated and healed by date of tag in (barrows only no gilts)

Quality Assurance: Exhibitor and one parent/quardian must attend one of the sessions offered in

Washington County or any other Ohio County.

Skillathon: Skillathon is **required** for all 4-H & FFA members to be eligible to exhibit, show and sell their project

animals.

What happens at the Fair?

Fair Weigh-In – Wednesday 5-8 pm (Last name A-G 5-6pm, Last name H-L 6-7pm, Last name M-Z 7-8pm)

Hogs will be weighed **ONLY ONCE – NO EXCEPTIONS**

(completed DUNF must be presented to committee before weighing in)

Buyer Thank you posters – make a Thank You poster to thank previous buyer. Hang it in the barn. See Jr Fair Guide for details and size.

Pictures – 11am – 6pm Thursday in show arena <u>taken by exhibitor</u>, <u>or taken prior to fair</u>. <u>Exhibitor must provide</u> buyer a 5x7 color photo at the sale.

Classes – To be eligible to sell, exhibitor *must do both* Showmanship and Market

Showmanship, Friday 8 am – (determined by age – Senior Division first)

Market Classes, Friday, immediately following Showmanship classes (determined by weight)

What is the Premier Exhibitor Award?

High scoring exhibitor from skillathon (100 points), showmanship (100 points) & market class placing (50 points) **Sale** – Saturday, 4:30 pm – Hog Barn (Buyers Reception – 3:30 pm)

What happens after the Sale?

Thank/contact buyers – thank buyers by note, call or in person

Sale Checks – checks are mailed directly to the exhibitors by the Waterford Fair Board after payment from buyers has been made. If you have questions on your checks contact Waterford Fair Board.
