The Washington County CARTEENS "Caution and Responsibility" program is a traffic safety educational program for first time juvenile traffic offenders. The program is two hours long and is designed to increase traffic safety knowledge and decrease second time juvenile traffic offenders.

CARTEENS is a cooperative program conducted by The Ohio State University Extension, Washington County; Ohio State Patrol, Marietta Post; and the Washington County Juvenile Court partnered with Ohio 4-H.

CARTEENS presenters are teens from Washington County who prepare and present the hands on activities, and learning objectives. Topics covered include excessive speed, driving under the influence, seat belt safety, distracted driving, and understanding traffic laws and signals. Members are required to complete a 4-H project thru CARTEENS membership. Projects may be of the members' interests with a required project evaluation in July. CARTEENS members are eligible for 4-H scholarships, trips, and other awards through Ohio 4-H.

CARTEENS is held monthly on the 2nd Wednesday of each month from 7:00-9:00pm at the OSU Extension Office, Washington County 1115 Gilman Ave. Marietta Ohio.
