Welcome to the 4-H Horse Program in Washington County! We are excited for the 2023 horse program year to begin. Please be aware the Junior Fair Guide will give exhibitors information regarding skillathon, equine sessions, the Washington County 4-H Horse Program Guidelines, and Washington County Fair rules. This horse packet will include horse dates, forms, and Saddle Horse Committee Members information. Please be sure to read the junior fair guide and complete all necessary forms in this packet. We have combined the PAS and Fair forms 1 packet for all our horse project members. Washington County will be hosting a PAS (Performance Against Standards) show on June 3, 2023. Any exhibitor who wants to attend The Ohio State Fair and compete with their horse must first qualify at a PAS show. Please be aware of the following dates:
