What is 4-H camp?



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Washington County 4-H Camps

All youth are invited to participate in the county camping programs. 4-H members attend at a discounted rate. See 4-H Calendar for Camp dates. Youth are eligible to attend resident 4-H Camps based on youths 'school grade level and age:

- Day Camp: Cloverbud Camp: All youth ages 5-8 (5 yr. olds must have completed kindergarten before attending camp)
- Overnight Camps: Beginner Camp: All youth who have completed 2nd grade and through the age of 10;
 Junior
- 4-H Junior Camp: All youth who have completed grades 3 to 6
- Senior 4-H Camp: All youth completing grades 6 to 9
